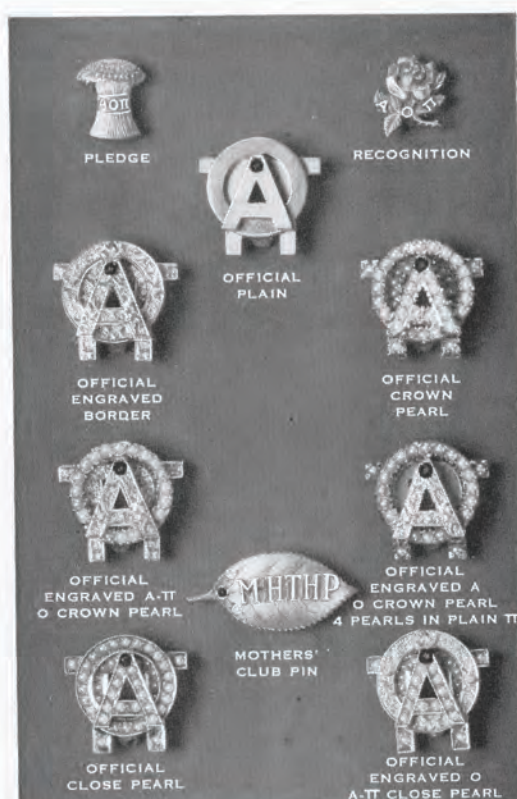
YOUR DAUGHTER is among the fortunate fifteen hundred young women chosen each year to be a part of the eighty-four collegiate chapters of Alpha Omicron Pi. After a short orientation period as an AOII pledge she will become an initiated member to enjoy the privileges and opportunities of friendship for her lifetime.

YOUR DAUGHTER'S pledge training is intended to be valuable to her. The purpose of it is to continue your emphasis on moral, social and intellectual values. To be eligible for initiation, your daughter must reflect AOII's standards — good scholarship, participation in campus activities, knowledge of her fraternity and adjustment to college and sorority experience.

YOUR DAUGHTER is expected to regard seriously the academic portion of college life. Good study habits, regular class attendance and adequate preparation of assignments will be encouraged through the chapter's scholarship program. Both AOII and the college require a minimum grade average for initiation. To be eligible for initiation, she must meet a grade average required by AOII and the college.

YOUR DAUGHTER'S chapter is guided by a group of alumnae members who are well qualified to serve as advisers.

YOUR DAUGHTER is among the fortunate fifteen hundred member of AOII. She will purchase it through the Central Office from the official jeweler. It will be hers to wear for her lifetime. The cost of pins varies with selection.

YOUR DAUGHTER has financial obligations to her chapter and the National organization. They are:

Pledge Fee \$25.00, \$10.00 of which is sent to National
 Pledge dues \$12.50 per month
 Initiation Fee \$80.00, \$40.00 of which is sent to National. This includes life subscription to magazine.
 Initiate dues \$14.00 per month
 Room rent \$130.00 per semester or month ^{per quarter}
 Board \$170.00 per month ^{quarter meal}
 Building pledge \$15.00 per year ^{quarter} month
 Parlor Fee \$5.00 per month for those not living in the house
 Social Fee None per semester or month.

YOUR DAUGHTER will receive monthly bills. After the 10th of the month accounts are delinquent and a fine may be levied. If you prefer, make checks payable to Alpha Omicron Pi and send directly to:
