

Applicant has left inguinal hernia. It cannot be kept reduced with a truss on account of the large size of the inguinal ring. The hernia is increasing gradually in size. He cannot perform manual labor for undue physical exertion tends to and does cause an increase in the size of the hernia. For him to continuously perform manual labor would render him a confined invalid and infringe his life on account of the increased size of hernia and other complications that would consequently arise.
